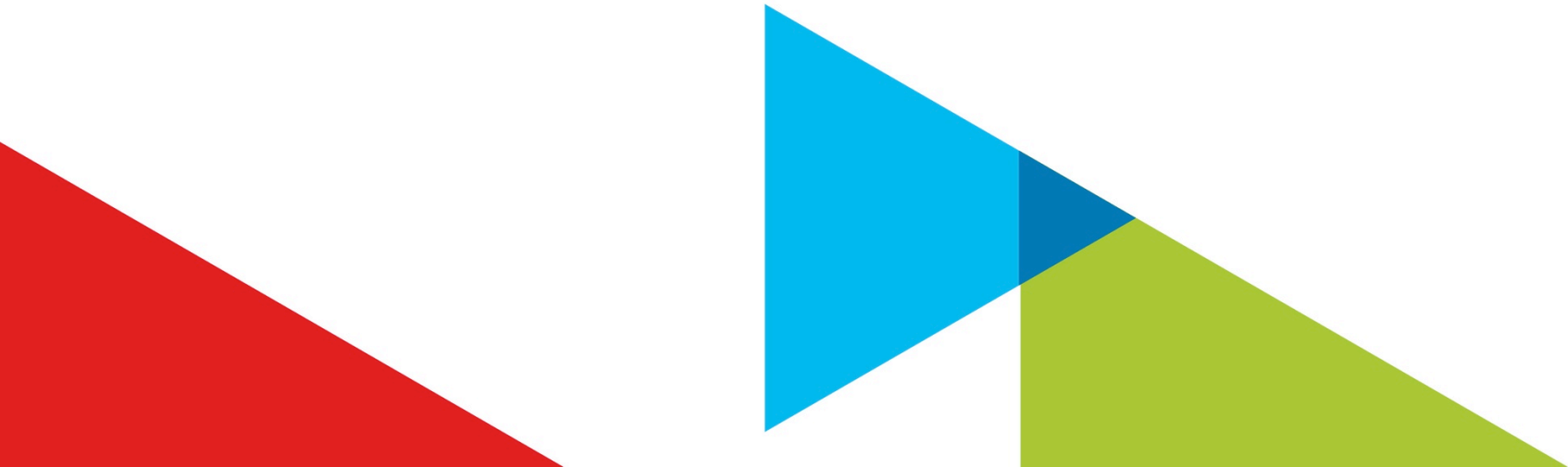




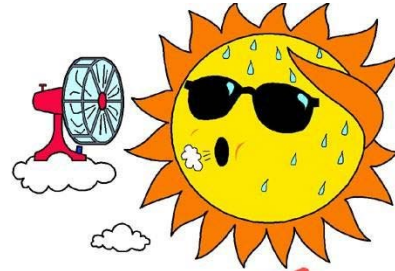

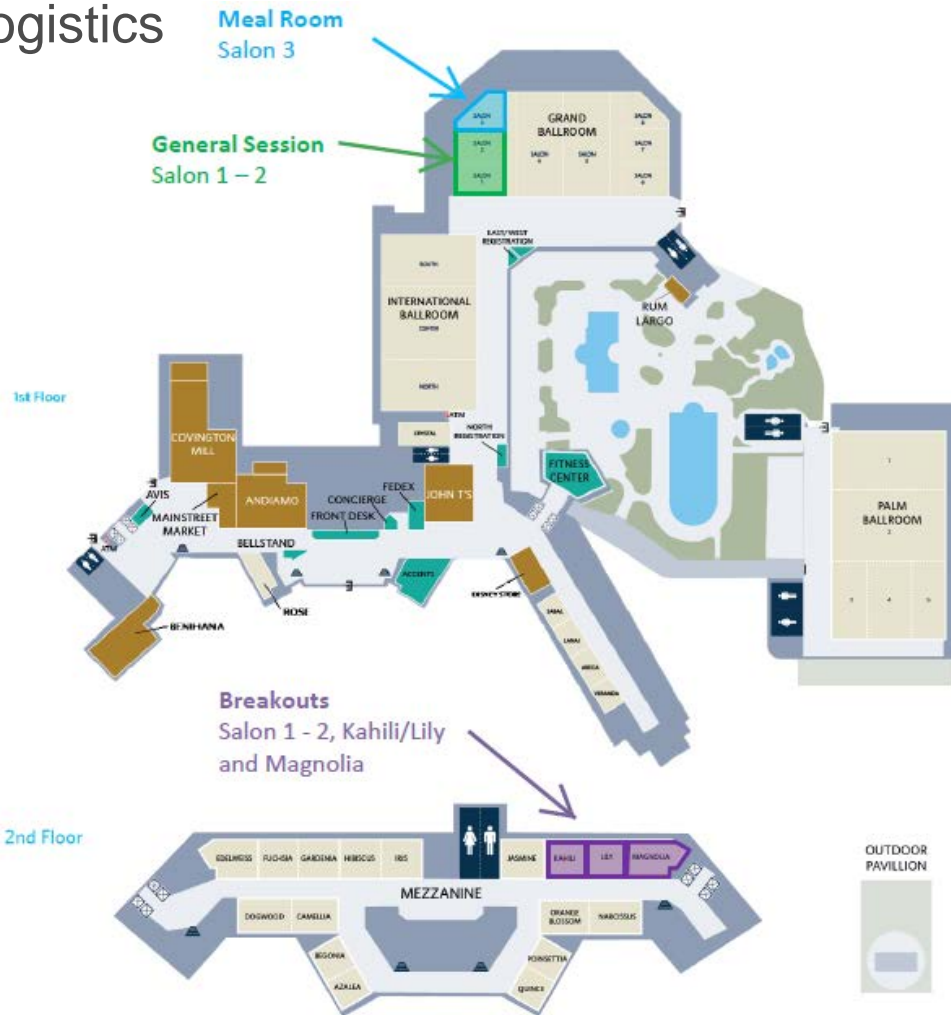

CMBG Update



- The CMBG Steering Committee met in January and discussed Vendor involvement in conferences.
- The committee recognized the direction in the industry is that most utilities utilize Engineers of Choice to perform CM activities (Engineering Changes).
- The CMBG Principles and Practices document was updated and approved by the committee to include:
 - Vendors may be used to assist a conference host or be a conference host.
 - All vendors will be given equal consideration with final selection and approval being made by the steering committee.
 - While no specific vendor time is scheduled during the conference, they may set up a table to provide information prior to and after sessions during the conference.
 - Prior approval must be obtained with the conference host and steering committee.
